10.0 SPORT PROTEST PROCEDURE:

Protests are decided by Race jury appointed according to FIS (Federation International de Ski) rules. A protest fee of \$25 applies and is refunded if the protest is successful.

16.0 DISTRICT TEAMS SELECTION CRITERIA

District team selection will be based on:

For each age category (K1, K2 and J1/J2), the district team will comprised of the top two male and female competitors from that zone, as determined from their race results held in mid-January 2010 at a site to be determined by Alpine Saskatchewan. Alternates to the team will be ranked by the same method.

The race will be a Bachleda format (refer to www.saskalpine.com/LinkClick.aspx?fileticket=0b8PvKl1Kr0%3d). Points assignment is determined by placing (i.e. 1st, 2nd, 3rd, etc) within each age category (K1, K2, and J1) in each qualifying race – regardless of athlete district.

Points result is based on World Cup points (see full reference at www.fis-ski.com/data/document/wcall-edition-2008.pdf section 10) assigned for placing in each. Competitors ranking first to 30th (single events and Combined) are awarded points in accordance with the following schedule:

The highest points result is awarded 1st ranking for qualifying, next lowest awarded 2nd, and so on.

Results will be verified by the Officials Chair, Alpine Saskatchewan.
